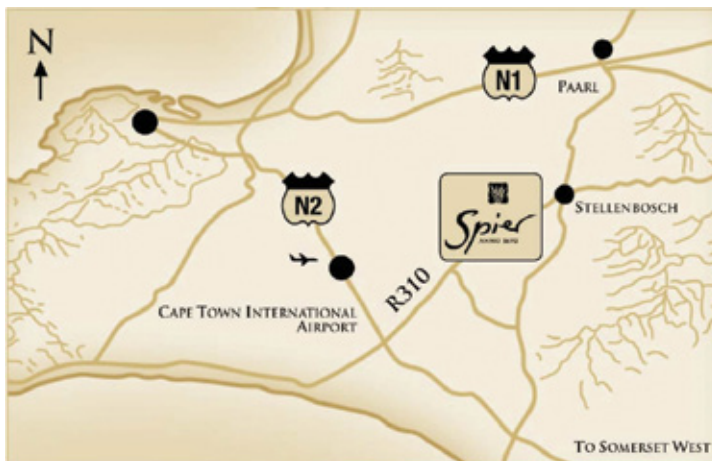

- From Adam Tas road (railway on right) go past Simonsberg Cheeses and Bergkelder
- Turn right at the sign for Cape Town and Kuils River onto R310
- At sign for Muizenberg, turn left onto R310
- Spier will be on your left hand side in 4km
- If you go past Neethlingshof turn back - Spier is +- 5 km down the road on the left

From Cape Town (N2)

- Take the N2 towards Cape Town International Airport
- Continue past the Airport turnoff, this is approximately 10 km after the cooling towers
- Take exit 33 which is the Baden Powell Drive/ R310 Stellenbosch turn off
- Turn left in the direction of Stellenbosch
- Spier is 9 km down the road on the right

From Durbanville (N1)

- Take N1 and exit 47
- Turn right at the stop sign and continue to Stellenbosch on the R44
- As you drive into Stellenbosch keep straight and you will get into Adam Tas road which has the railway line on its right. Go past Simonsberg Cheeses and Bergkelder
- Turn right at the sign for Cape Town and Kuils River onto R310
- At sign for Muizenberg, turn left onto R310
- If you go past Neethlingshof turn back - Spier is +- 5 km down the road on the left

Session 1 11:00 – 12:00

Plastic Surgery now

By: Dr Dirk Lazarus



There have been many recent advances in plastic surgery. A greater understanding of aging and anatomy, new concepts of beauty, more sophisticated patient demands and advances in anaesthesia and surgery mean that plastic surgery as practiced today is very different from how it was done in the recent past. In this session advances in plastic surgery will be outlined, especially in relation to facial rejuvenation, breast enhancement and body shaping.

Dr Dirk Lazarus has been in practice since 1998. His practice focusses exclusively on cosmetic surgery, specializing in facial rejuvenation, breast enhancement and body shaping procedures. Dr Lazarus has his own small ambulatory surgical facility - Tranquillity Clinic, where he performs surgery. The only reconstructive work that Dr Lazarus performs is repair of cleft lip and palate in young children. He also heads the Cleft Lip and Palate Unit at Red Cross.
